4.	<p>AOB</p> <p>Highland Core Paths Improvement Project Members will be asked to help prioritise applications for funding.</p> <p>Core Paths Capital Project This is a budget of £100,000 for core paths or paths across the Highlands likely to become core paths that are on land owned or managed by The Highland Council. The link path between Balloch and Sunnyside may be a target for £10,000 of that budget.</p> <p>Scottish Natural Heritage SNH have withdrawn from the LAF although they are prepared to attend particular sessions to address specific issues. Forestry Commission Scotland may be in a similar position.</p> <p>Access Issues 7 new cases have been reported; one an anonymous complaint about the new overtaking lane being built at Moy and its effect on a right of way and old military road.
